I would also like to thank the majority of parents and carers for respecting the school's protocols on social distancing and the wearing of face masks on the premises, which both help to keep us all safe.

A polite reminder to all parents and carers that:

- The school office is closed. Please phone the school office or e-mail enquiries@claycots.com if you have a question for our team.
- When you have dropped off/collected your child, please depart from the premises immediately as this assists with ensuring social distancing.
- Parents are responsible for maintaining social distancing on premises. Please ensure that
 when classes are being dismissed, you wait well back so that teachers can dismiss the
 children safely and to ensure that you are distanced from other parents.
- Face masks: Parents and carers should wear a face covering at all times when on the premises.

We will continue to review our re-opening procedures and protocols and are grateful for the constructive feedback that we have received from parents to date.

Information:

- Children may bring a packed lunch to school or have a hot meal. Please note that if you
 are a parent of a child in Year 3, you will now have to pay for your child's meal as they are
 not covered by universal meals for YR,1 or 2. If you believe that you may be in receipt of
 benefits related Free School Meals, please contact the school.
- Pupils in Year 5 and Year 6 are permitted to walk to and from school alone, if the parent/carer consents. Parents of Year 5 and 6 pupils will receive a letter electronically.
 Please complete this if you wish to give consent. All children in other year groups must be escorted to and from school by an appropriate adult.



• Children are permitted to come to school in their PE kit on a PE day. They do not need to bring a uniform to change into. On all other days, children should wear a full Claycots school uniform.

SCL Childcare:

Please be aware that the uptake of SCL wrap around child care (breakfast club and after school provision) is very low. Should there not be an increase in pupils attending, SCL will review the viability of offering this service at both campuses or whether this provision should be based at one of the Claycots campuses.
