- They come to school in the correct uniform.






Positive behaviours are rewarded through whole school systems which include:


- Recognition board displayed in all classrooms

School Uniform



Boys

- Plain white cotton shirt (with a turn down collar)
- School tie
- A V-Neck green school jumper (with Claycots logo)
- Black or grey trousers
- Black or grey socks
- Flat black school shoes



School Uniform



<u>Girls</u>

- Plain white cotton shirt (with a turn down collar)
- School tie
- A V-Neck school jumper or school cardigan (both with the Claycots logo)
- Black or grey skirt
- White or grey socks or grey tights
- Flat black school shoes
- In the summer term, girls may wear a green checked summer dress.





P.E Kit



- House team coloured T-shirts (with logo) –
- Bray (red), Dorney (blue), Thames (yellow) and Jubilee (green)
- Bottle green or black jogging bottoms
- Bottle green or black plain jumper (no hood or zip)
- Bottle green or black shorts
- Black plimsolls or non marking trainers

Year 2 will have their P.E. lesson on a Tuesday. Children must come into school every Tuesday in their P.E. kit. There is no need to bring in any other uniform as they will stay in their P.E. kit all day.

Independent Children



Establishing routines at the start of the day:

- Home reading book left in the class tray on a Monday. Books will be changed on this days. Please ensure you sign your child's reading record book.
- Letters or notes handed to the teacher

Establishing routines at the end of the day:

- Collect reading book on book day
- Collect water bottle, lunchbox and coat.
- Collect letters when appropriate

What does a day in Year 2 involve?



- Registration and morning task
- Phonics
- English
- Break and Fruit time
- Maths
- Lunch
- Afternoons consist of Shared/Guided Reading, Handwriting, RE, PSHE, Art, DT, History, Geography, Comprehension, PE, Spanish, Music and Computing.
- Reading a class book

Assessment in Year 2



- Assessment is ongoing everyday
- Teachers are constantly assessing children's progress to plan their next step
- Every half term we also have an assessment week.
 Assessment week allows the teacher to assess the child's progress during that half term in Reading, Writing, Phonics and Maths.

Assessment in Year 2

- As your child did not sit the National Phonics Screening Test at the end of Year 1 due to school closure, your child will be tested in November 2020 this year. Your child will be taught phonics twice a day.
- Formal national assessments for all children in Year 2 will also take place during the May 2021 these are known as SATs which assess children's grasp of English and Mathematics.
- Your child will sit a paper for the following; English grammar, punctuation and spelling, English reading, Mathematics mental arithmetic and Mathematics reasoning.
- Further information regarding SATs will be shared at a later point this year.

Reading

- Reading is one of the most important skill you can help your child develop.
- Please listen to your child read every day.
- Please read to your child every day.
- Ask your child questions about what they have read, they need to develop an understanding of the text to support their comprehension skills.
- Write a note when you have heard your child read in their Reading Record Book.

What you can do to help your child?



- Ensure they have a good nights sleep
- Give them a healthy breakfast
- Prepare them for each day e.g. P.E. Kits, reading books, water bottles.
- Ensure your child is punctual.
- Work on your child's targets that will be shared by your child's class teacher at a later date.
- Continue to practise phonics up to Phase 5 at home.



Independent children

Encourage your child to be **independent**. We expect children to:

 Carry their own book bags, water bottle, hand letters/notes to the teacher.

 Collect homework, reading books, lunch boxes, coats, jumpers, water bottle and letters ready for home time.



Class reminders

At Claycots we promote a healthy lifestyle

Water bottle

We ask that your child has a <u>named</u> sports cap water bottle in school everyday. This must **only be filled with water and not juice.**

Morning snack

A fruit will be provided by the school for morning break however, if you wish to send in your own snack this must be a **fruit only**. No biscuits/crisps/breakfast bars etc.

Lunch

Up until the end of Year 2 children may receive a **free school lunch**. If you do wish to provide a packed lunch instead, please ensure this a **healthy**, **balanced meal**. Sweets/chocolates/fizzy drinks are not permitted.
