

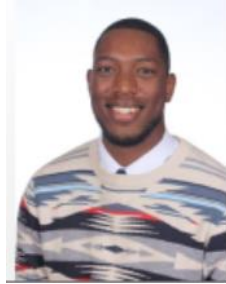


Welcome to Year 4!

- ▶ Mrs Khan - 4FK



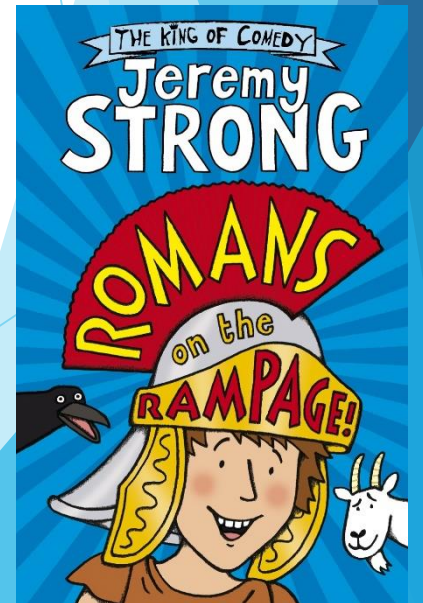
The wider teaching team includes:
