### **Positive Covid Case in Year 4**

#### **Advice to Parents & Carers of children in Year 4 – Instruction to Self-Isolate until Monday 28th December for Year 4 Year Group - All Classes (Britwell Campus)**

Dear Parents and Carers,

Sadly, I am writing to you during the Christmas Break as there has been another positive case at the Britwell Campus.

We have been advised by Public Health England that there has been a confirmed case of COVID-19 within your child's year group. The positive case attended school on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> December 2020.

Public Health England have instructed us that due to the close contact that may have taken place, the school should inform the whole year group to self-isolate.

All staff and children in Year 4 should stay at home and self-isolate as a precaution for 10 days.

**This means that all children in Year 4 should self-isolate until Monday 28<sup>th</sup> December 2020.**

**Children can return to school on Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> January 2021.**

#### **Symptoms of COVID-19**

The most common symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are recent onset of:

- a new continuous cough
- a high temperature
- a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)
