Positive Covid Case in Year Nursery- Britwell Campus

Advice to Parents & Carers of children in Nursery: Instruction to Self-Isolate until Sunday 27th December for Nursery Year Group - All Nursery children (Britwell Campus)

Dear Parents and Carers,

Sadly, I am writing to you during the Christmas Break as there has been another positive case at the Britwell Campus.

We have been advised by Public Health England that there has been a confirmed case of COVID-19 within your child's year group. The positive case attended school on Wednesday 16th December 2020.

Public Health England have instructed us that due to the close contact that may have taken place, the school should inform the whole of Nursery to self-isolate.

All staff and children in Nursery should stay at home and self-isolate as a precaution for 10 days.

This means that all children in Year Nursery should self-isolate until Sunday 27^h December 2020.

Children can return to school on Tuesday 5th January 2021.

Symptoms of COVID-19

The most common symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are recent onset of:

- a new continuous cough
- a high temperature
- a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)
